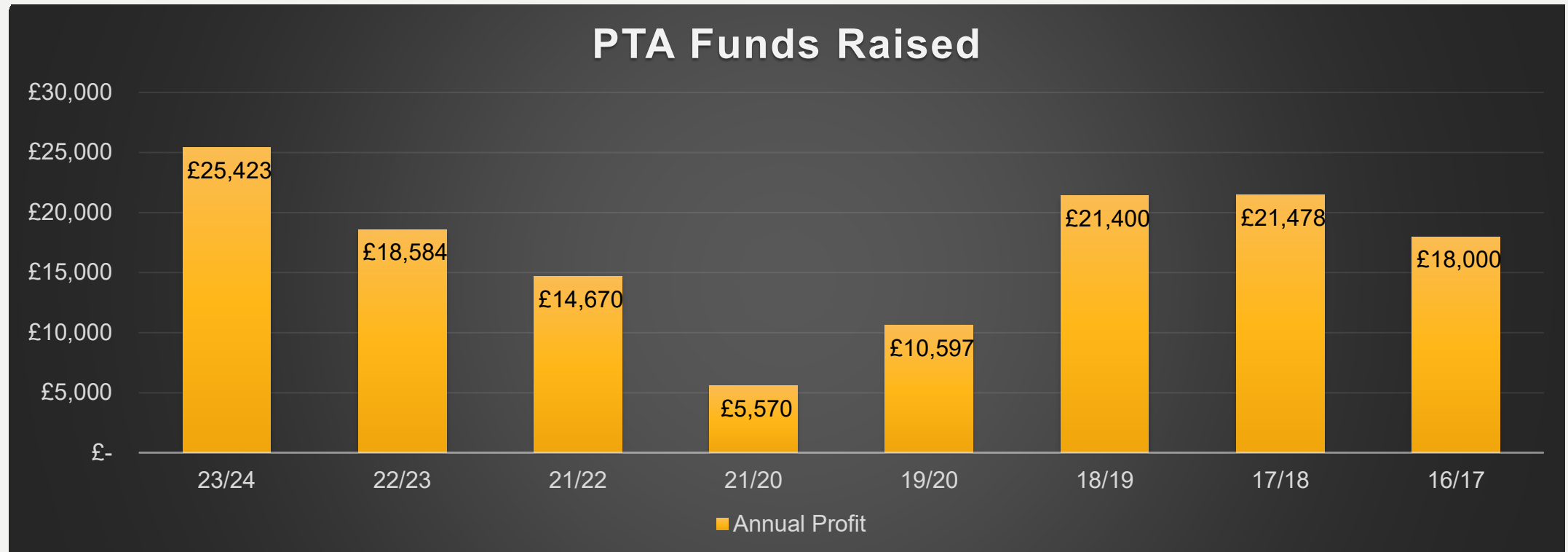
Events Committees

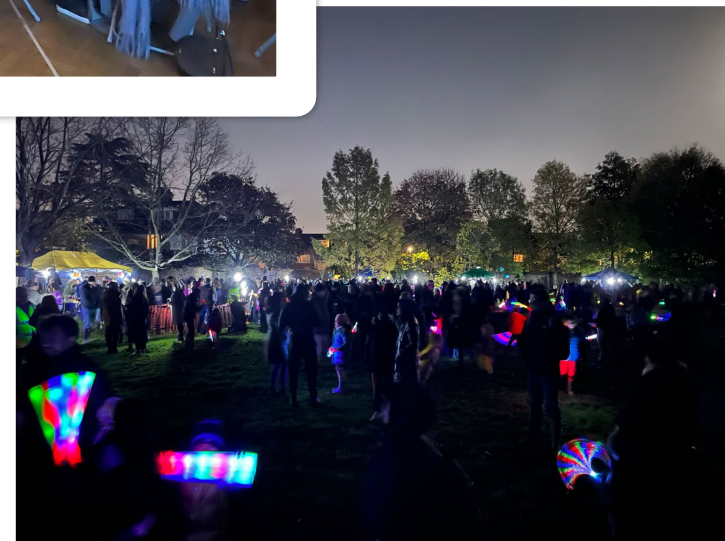

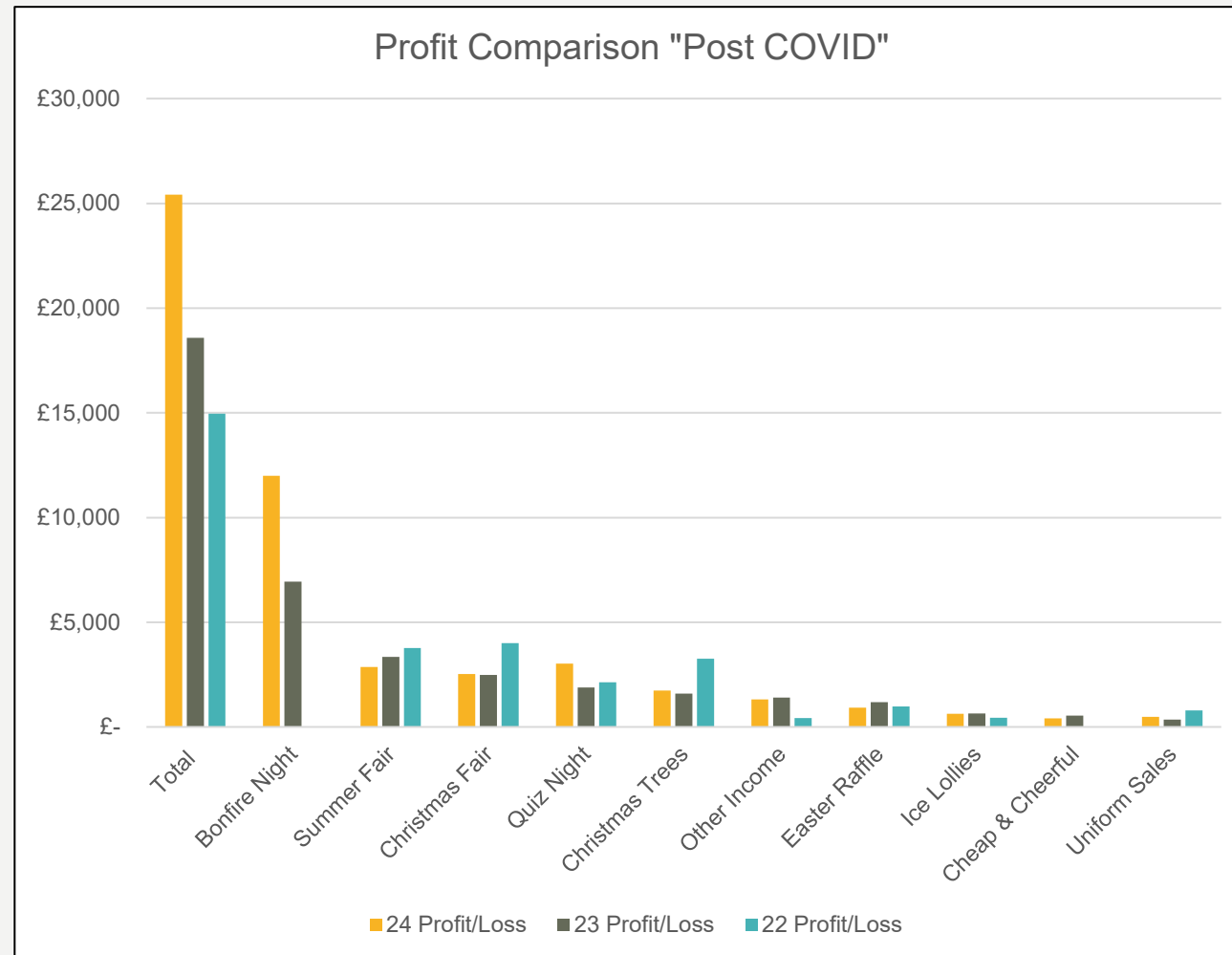
HOW DID WE RAISE IT?

FUNDRAISING COMPARISON



- Bonfire profits nearly doubled— collective memory on the event committee was vital to tighten margins.
- Lower attendance at some key events (Xmas Fair, Summer Fair)
- Continued pressure on profit margins (Xmas Trees)
